Gentlemen

With regards to D. Hamilton's Complaint -
I do refer to the Breaker working at Falan for Contractor
H. Deery. I saw the Machine at work there and there
was nothing to prevent anyone passing. Perhaps
he refers to the metal spreads for Roller near
Bunessane.

It is very seldom a Breaker is working
on any particular road, perhaps once in the Year,
and only then a couple of days or so with any
Contractor.

I notice that some roads are, with reason
complained of. There are lying out of Contract
and if the local parties affected would aid
in finding contractors for them it would be much
appreciated and effect something practical.

For one apparently taking an interest
in the roads it is hard to reconcile a Complaint
over an inconvenience which, at any time, could
