GMD 01/14 ELECTION OF CATHAOIRLEACH

On the proposal of Cllr. Gallagher, seconded by Cllr. Bonner, Cllr Terence Slowey was elected Cathaoirleach of the Glenties Municipal District.

GMD 02/14 ELECTION OF LEAS-CHATHAOIRLEACH

On the proposal of Cllr. O Domhnaill, seconded by Cllr. Gallagher Cllr Bonner was elected Leas - Chathaoirleach of the Glenties Municipal District.

GMD 03/14 ELECTION OF 2 NO. REPRESENTATIVES TO COISTE NA GAEILGE
