- 2) That this Council request funding from Central Council and the Department of Transport to widen the Bridges at the bottom of Meenaroy in Glenswilly (R250).
- 3) That this Council prioritise the footpath out to Conwal Graveyard from future footpath or CIS funding. The footpath is a health hazard for runners and walkers and is too narrow.
- 4) That this Council negotiate with the OPW and Bord Failte to have a scenic route to Glenveagh National Park via New Mills, Churchill and Gartan.
