Notice is hereby given that Donegal County Council has made an Order to have the following roads closed to traffic on the date and times indicated to facilitate the St. Patrick's Day Parade.

- Justice Walsh Road at Upper Main Street
- Rosemount Lane at Upper Main Street
- Church Lane at Upper Main Street
- Market Square at Upper Main Street
- Lower Main Street
- Fortwell Court at Lower Main Street
- Oliver Plunket at Lower Main Street
- Burnside Park at Lower Main Street
- Larkins Lane at Lower Main Street
- Old Town Road from Lower Main Street Dunnes Entrance
