



## Donegal County Council Home Safety Check Sheet

Detection! Smoke / Heat and Carbon Monoxide Alarms:
Is there a minimum of one working smoke alarm at each level?  Do you test smoke alarms weekly?  Are smoke alarms less than 10 years old?  Is there a heat detector in your kitchen?  Are there carbon monoxide alarms in the room(s) where gas appliances, oil or solid fuels is being used?  If your escape is through another room, does that room have a smoke detector?  If your escape is through another room, does that room have a smoke detector?
Prevention! Housekeeping issues:
Are your chimneys cleaned annually?  Are extension leads checked that they are not overloaded?  Is there a fire blanket in the kitchen?  Is there a working fire extinguisher in the kitchen?  Are matches/lighters kept in a safe location away from young children?  Are chargers CE certified and used only on hard surfaces?
Routine! Last thing at night:
Are all unnecessary electrical appliances switched off?  All doors are closed and escape routes unobstructed?  All candles/incense burners put out?  A spark guard is placed in front of open fires?  All cigarettes are fully put out and ashtrays emptied safely?  A key for each escape window and door is immediately available?
Evacuation! Escape Plan:
Do all occupants know what to do if they discover a fire?   Do you have an alternative escape route arranged?   Do you have a pre-arranged external assembly point, known to all occupants?   Following your escape, do you have a means of raising the alarm?   Do all the occupants of the house know to call either '999' or '112' in the event of a fire?   Do the occupants know the Eircode of the house?

Smoke alarms - Test Weekly - Obvious dangers - Plan escape route = STOP!
