## National Framework for living with COVID-19



The National Framework for Living with Covid-19 sets out the measures that will be taken at each of five risk levels. The purpose of the Framework is to allow for national as well as localised management of the virus.

The infection rate in Dublin has now risen to a point that **Dublin City and County is now at Level 3.** 

The rest of Ireland remains at Level 2.
