

Notice of Determination of the Need for Strategic Environmental Assessment (SEA) of the Proposed Variation to the County Donegal Development Plan 2018-2024 in respect of the TEN-T Priority Route Improvement Project, Donegal (Variation No. 1)

Donegal County Council has prepared a Proposed Variation to the County Donegal Development Plan 2018-2024 in respect of the TEN-T Priority Route Improvement Project, Donegal (Variation No. 1).

In accordance with Article 13K(1) of the Planning and Development Regulations 2001 (as amended) the Planning Authority has considered whether or not the Proposed Variation would be likely to have significant effects on the environment.

On the basis of said consideration and in accordance with Article 13K(2) of the Planning and Development Regulations 2001 (as amended) the Planning Authority has determined that the Proposed Variation would be likely to have significant effects on the environment. Consequently a Strategic Environmental Assessment of the proposed variation is required and shall be carried out in respect of said Proposed Variation. A copy of said Determination, as contained in a Chief Executive's Order, has been made available for public inspection at the offices of the Planning Authority and in public libraries and has also been uploaded to the Council's website (www.donegalcoco.ie) in accordance with Article 13K(5)(a) of said regulations.
