All instructions given in the MSDS are to be followed. Do not allow hazardous materials to come into contact with the eye, lips or skin and use appropriate PPE. Do not eat, drink or smoke when using or handling hazardous materials. Do not inhale vapours from hazardous materials. All hazardous materials are to be stored in a secure area as per MSDS guidelines. Personal Protective Equipment is provided and is to be worn by workers using hazardous materials as indicated in the MSDS. The location of fire extinguishers should be noted by workers using flammable materials. Smoking is not permitted. Suitable material is to be used to mop up all spillages as soon as they occur. Workers using hazardous materials shall use the washing facilities and follow good hygiene practice. Risk assessment to be carried out when using chemicals. MSDS are to be maintained and updated when applicable in the area in which the Chemical area used. Assessment of weather conditions must be carried out prior to commencement of work Surveying of the area to be covered is needed to avoid accidental contamination. Disposal of Pesticides must be done in accordance with the MSDS. Chemicals must never come in contact with the eyes – use goggles provided. Plan storage so no Chemicals which have a reaction to each other are stored together. Provide suitable First Aid Facilities, including eye wash stations, consider drench showers if applicable.
